The two main locations for the festival are in and around Birmingham Hippodrome and Bullring & Grand Central.

1. Birmingham Hippodrome



This is the entrance to Birmingham Hippodrome.

In this area you will find an Access Hub. You can ask questions and get ear defenders, fidget toys and audio description headsets.










This area will also have a dancefloor and a DJ where you will be able to watch the dancing and listen to the music.

Inside the Thorp Street entrance there will be an exhibition and workshops that you can participate in. Please ask at the Access Hub if you want assistance with participating in this.


























This is Thorp Street.

Here, you will see dancing and listen to music.






4. Patrick Studio

5. Bullring & Grand Central

6. Toilets

- 2. Ground floor for a low crowd area.












ACCESS HUBS
