	<p>Where?</p> <p>Hippodrome Square</p>
	<p>When?</p> <p>12pm – 6pm</p>
 	<p>What you need to know:</p> <p>Lumini is a special sculpture made up of small dome-like structures that link together all lit with beautiful lighting and wonderful colours which change depending on the sun and time of day.</p> <p>You start at the reception area where you are asked to take off your shoes and given a map.</p> <p>Once inside you are free to follow your map and explore the installation or you can find a cosy pod where you can simply sit and lie back and enjoy the atmosphere, made special by the beautiful sounds especially composed for this immersive soundscape.</p>
